---

- To develop an online course for health professionals
- To increase the number of participants at in-person trainings
- To expand links with the Secretary of Health
- To evaluate the impact that EIMMEXICO has had with its training
- To continue with forums at the national level, involving the Ministry of Health of each state
- To publish physical activity guides for Type 1, 2 and gestational diabetes with CENETEC (National center of technological excellence in health)

## **Past Accomplishments**

---

- We have worked closely with the secretary of Health (CENAPRECE) in collaborating events to training and update all doctors in the Mexican republic
- Currently, we have coordinated with 11 Mexican states for the training of doctors and health professionals
- Have hosted more than 20 courses and trained more than 500 attendees at our healthcare provider courses
- Also, with the Secretary of Health, and the subdivision of medical care, we are working in the area of disability to include this sector of the population in health care and to provide physicians with the tools to work with these patients
- We have held two forums on economy and health and the impact of physical inactivity
- We have worked with not only physicians, but different professions and the general public, to provide education to improve the health of the country
